Our landlord has agreed to release more space for our use at Gladstone Shed. Terms have yet to be agreed but we are planning to

- Release space near to the workshop by shifting an SC wood store to space opposite the workshop entrance
- Use the under-stairs space for exhibiting community projects and for some storage
- Re-plan the outside space subject to the approval of SC and the Borough Council Planning Dept.
